- b. a certification body as a member of the International Personnel Certification Association for certification of auditors; or
- c. Other certification body offering certification of auditors recognized by HKICA
- d. University programme accredited courses

Note 2:

Application fee already covered the first-year annual fee for training organization

Note 3:

Annual maintenance fee for Programme recognition already covered the annual fee for training organization

Note 4:

Appeal fee is non-refundable despite of the results of the appeal (for decision of approval, withdrawal or reduction of scope of approval including number of training establishment or courses)

Note 5:

Scheme can be CSQMSA (ISO 9001), CSEMSA (ISO 14001), CSOH&SMSA (ISO 45001), CSMLA (ISO 15189) and CST&CLA (ISO 17025) or any other scheme as developed by HKICA and IPC
